DO NOT FLUSH:

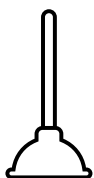
Paper towels, baby wipes, disinfecting wipes, and any other so called "flushable" wipes, sponges, rags, towels, feminine products, diapers, cotton swabs/ cotton balls, needles, and any other trash items.

These items are detrimental to wastewater collection systems. They can get hung up on pump impellers, combine with fats, oils, and grease (FOG), and form large balls in sewer pipes that can cause blockages and backups. These incidents can be not only costly but can result in a significant public health concern. These items do not disintegrate like toilet paper when wet and should be properly discarded in your trash can!

Please properly dispose of all other trash items in your trash can and refrain from flushing anything other than bodily waste and toilet paper into the wastewater collection system.
